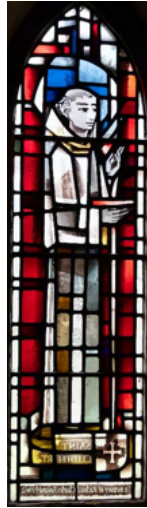
Everyone's welcome. You're invited, no matter your background or beliefs. It's free and there's no pressure to come back. And do think of a friend you could invite and come along with them!

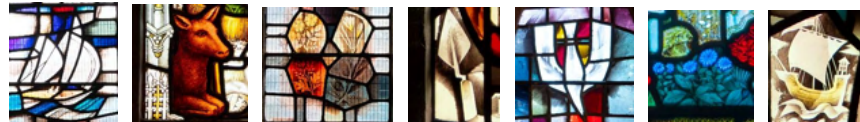
